

EUROPEAN BOARD OF PLASTIC RECONSTRUCTIVE AND AESTHETIC SURGERY SYLLABUS

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I. GENERAL PROCEDURES

(independent of primary site)

1. Primary suture of simple non-complicated wound or laceration
2. Drainage of subcutaneous haematoma, seroma or purulent infection
3. Wound debridement, Biopsy

II. HEAD AND NECK

1. Facial Trauma

- Repair of soft tissue facial injuries
- Reduction and fixation of facial fracture
 - Upper third facial fracture
 - Middle third facial fracture (excluding the nose)
 - Nose fracture
 - Mandibular fracture
- Reoperative surgery for facial fracture
- Other

2. Orthognathic

- Le Fort I osteotomy
- Bilateral sagittal split osteotomy
- Dentoalveolar maxillary/mandibular osteotomy and distraction
- Other maxillary/mandibular osteotomy and distraction
- Other

3. TMJ Disorders

- Open arthroscopy/arthroscopy for TMJ disorder
- TMJ reconstruction (autologous or implant)
- Other

4. Cleft Lip/Palate and Craniofacial surgery

- Cleft lip/palate repair
 - Dentofacial orthopaedics/orthodontics
 - Primary cleft lip repair
 - Primary cleft nose repair
 - Primary cleft palate repair
 - Secondary cleft lip repair
 - Secondary cleft nose repair
 - Secondary cleft palate repair
 - Alveolar bone grafting
 - Treatment of velopharyngeal incompetence
- Surgery for congenital (Crouzon, Apert, Pierre Robin, Treacher Collins, hemifacial microsomia, Romberg...) or acquired (posttraumatic) craniofacial anomalies
- Skull base surgery
- Other

5. Lip and Upper Aero-digestive Cancer

- Excision and direct closure/skin graft
- Excision and reconstruction with local flap
- Excision and reconstruction with regional flap
- Excision and reconstruction with microvascular flap
- Other

6. Facial Bone Tumours

- Mandibulectomy/ Maxillectomy/ Orbital exenteration
 - No reconstruction
 - Reconstruction with pedicled flap
 - Reconstruction with microvascular flap
- Complex Excision
 - No reconstruction or skin graft
 - Reconstruction with pedicled flap
 - Reconstruction with microvascular flaps
- Other

7. Salivary Gland

- Parotidectomy with facial nerve preservation
- Parotidectomy without facial nerve preservation
 - With immediate nerve graft
 - Without immediate nerve graft
- Submandibular gland removal
- Other

8. Ear

- Excision of lesion and direct closure/no reconstruction
- Excision of lesion and local/auricular flap repair
- Excision of lesion and distant flap or composite reconstruction
- Correction of prominent ears
- Surgery for microtia/complex ear reconstruction
- Other

9. Nose

- Excision of lesion and direct closure/skin graft
- Excision of lesion and local flap
- Excision of lesion and regional/composite reconstruction
- Correction of congenital/acquired deformities
- Other

10. Eyelids

- Excision and reconstruction of upper/lower lid
 - Reconstruction with direct closure or skin graft
 - Reconstruction with flap
- Excision and reconstruction of medial/ lateral cantus
 - Reconstruction with direct closure or skin graft
 - Reconstruction with flap
 - Correction of congenital/acquired deformities
- Other

11. Congenital/Acquired Neck Anomalies

- Repair of complex soft tissue neck injury
- Reconstruction of pterigium colli, torticollis congenita...
- Madelung's disease
- Pharyngostome and pharyngo-oesophageal reconstruction
 - With direct closure or local flap
 - With regional pedicled flap
 - With microvascular flap
- Excision of congenital neck cyst/fistula
- Neck dissection
- Other

12. Scalp Reconstruction

- Direct closure or skin graft
- Scalp flap
- Scalp expander
- Free tissue transfer
- Calvarial bone reconstruction (bone substitute or graft)
- Other

13. Facial Palsy

- Reconstruction with nerve graft
- Reconstruction with static procedure
- Reconstruction with dynamic procedure
 - With regional tissue
 - With microvascular procedure
- Adjuvant procedure for eyelid or corner of mouth
- Other

14. Other head and neck procedures

III. BREAST

1. Breast mound reconstruction

- Breast reconstruction with expander/implant
- Breast reconstruction with pedicled flap
- Breast reconstruction with microvascular flap

2. Nipple-areola complex reconstruction

3. Revision surgery for breast reconstruction

4. Glandulectomy for gynaecomastia with/without liposuction

5. Other breast procedures

IV. TRUNK AND ABDOMEN

1. Mediastinitis. Chest Wall and Trunk Reconstruction

- Mediastinitis. Reconstruction with autologous tissue
- Posttraumatic/ oncologic chest wall reconstruction
 - With direct closure/skin graft

- With pedicled flaps
- With synthetic mesh or bone substitute
- Without synthetic mesh or bone substitute
- 2. Pectus excavatum/carinatum**
- 3. Poland syndrome**

V. HAND AND UPPER EXTREMITY

- 1. Tendon Surgery**
 - Acute flexor tendon repair
 - Acute extensor tendon repair
 - Secondary flexor tendon reconstruction
 - With tendon graft
 - With tendon transfer
 - Other (tenolysis, arthrodesis,...)
 - Secondary extensor tendon reconstruction
 - With tendon graft
 - With tendon transfer
 - Boutonnière and Swan Neck deformities
 - Other (tenolysis, arthrodesis, tenodesis,...)
 - Other
- 2. Fractures And Dislocations**
 - Reduction and fixation of fracture or dislocation
 - Phalanx, interphalangeal joint
 - Metacarpal, metacarpophalangeal joint
 - Carpal bone
 - Distal radius or ulna
 - Sequelae of hand fracture (arthrolysis, tenolysis,...)
 - Surgery for Kienböck disease
 - Surgery for pseudoarthrosis of the hand or wrist
 - Other
- 3. Arthrodesis and Arthroplasty**
 - Arthrodesis
 - Arthroplasty
 - Implant arthroplasty
 - Interpositional/suspension arthroplasty
- 4. Peripheral Nerve Surgery**
 - Primary nerve suture
 - Neurolysis
 - Nerve reconstruction with nerve graft
 - Nerve reconstruction with vascularised nerve graft
 - Other
- 5. Compression Nerve Syndromes**
 - Median nerve decompression
 - Ulnar nerve decompression
 - Radial nerve decompression
 - Other
- 6. Tendon Transfers**
 - Tendon transfer for radial nerve palsy
 - Tendon transfer for median nerve palsy
 - Tendon transfer for ulnar nerve palsy
 - Tendon transfer for combined nerve palsy
 - Other
- 7. Brachial Plexus**
 - Primary suture of brachial plexus injury
 - Secondary nerve surgery for brachial plexus injury (neurolysis, nerve graft, nerve transfer)
 - Surgical treatment of brachial plexus injury sequelae (shoulder, elbow, wrist, hand)
 - Obstetric palsy
 - Other palsies of upper limb (spastic, cerebral, stroke)
- 8. Compartment Syndrome Of Upper Limb**
 - Fasciotomy for Compartment Syndrome
 - Treatment of sequelae of Compartment Syndrome
 - Other
- 9. Arthritis** (Osteoarthritis, Rheumatoid, Lupus, Gout, Psoriasis)
 - Arthritis of interphalangeal joints of long fingers
 - Arthritis of metacarpophalangeal joints of long fingers
 - Arthritis of wrist joint
 - Surgery of carpo-metacarpal joint of thumb

- Isolated tendon repair or reconstruction
- Treatment of boutonnière or swan neck deformities
- Other
- 10. Dupuytren's contracture**
 - Fasciectomy
 - Fasciectomy with full-thickness graft
 - Other
- 11. Congenital Hand Anomalies**
 - Syndactyly correction
 - Polydactyly correction
 - Clinodactyly correction
 - Camptodactyly correction
 - Other
- 12. Amputation and Replantation Surgery.** Amputation with direct closure
 - Amputation with flap
 - Microreplantation/revascularization
 - Macroreplantation/revascularization
 - Other
- 13. Skin Cover Of Upper Extremity**
 - Skin cover with skin graft
 - Skin cover with local flap
 - Skin cover with regional pedicled flap
 - Skin cover with distant pedicled flap (inguinal, chest)
 - Skin cover with free tissue transfer
- 14. Hand Burns**
 - Skin graft for burn of the hand
 - Skin flap for burn of the hand
 - Treatment of hand burn sequelae
 - Other
- 15. Thumb reconstruction**
 - Bone lengthening
 - Osteoplastic thumb reconstruction
 - Pollicisation
 - Toe-to-hand transfer
 - Other
- 16. Hand Tumours**
 - Excision of skin neoplasm
 - and direct closure
 - and local flap
 - and pedicled regional flap
 - and pedicle distant flap
 - and microvascular free tissue transfer
 - Other
 - Excision of bone neoplasm
 - and bone graft
 - Other
- 17. Wrist**
 - Arthroscopy/arthrotomy for wrist instability
 - Closed/open reduction of carpal/wrist dislocations
 - Other
- 18. Miscellaneous**
 - Surgery for tenosynovitis
 - Trigger finger release
 - Surgery for high pressure injection injuries
 - Foreign body removal
 - Surgery for vasospastic disorders of the hand
 - Other
- 19. Other hand procedures**

VI. LOWER EXTREMITY

- 1. Excision of tumours** of the lower extremity
 - Reconstruction with direct closure/skin graft
 - Reconstruction with local/regional/cross leg flap
 - Reconstruction with microvascular flap
- 2. Inguinal/groin lymph node dissection**
- 3. Surgery for open/complex fracture of the lower extremity**
 - Soft tissue cover
 - With local/pedicled flap
 - With microvascular flap
 - Bone reconstruction
 - With bone graft
 - With pedicled bone flap/microvascular bone flap/bone lengthening
 - Other
- 4. Treatment of vascular ulcer**
 - With skin graft

- 5. Diabetic foot**
 - Amputation
 - Reconstruction with regional tissue
 - Reconstruction with microvascular surgery
 - Other

- 1. Surgery for hypospadias**
 - Meatotomy
 - Urethroplasty
 - Surgery for fistula, stenosis and stricture
- 2. Surgery for epispadias or extrophy of bladder**
- 3. Surgery for Peyronie's disease**
- 4. Fournier's gangrene**
 - Reconstruction with skin graft
 - Reconstruction with skin flap
- 5. Gender reassignment surgery / Replantation of penis**
 - Phalloplasty
 - With pedicled flap
 - With microvascular flap
 - Other
- 6. Vaginal reconstruction**
 - With skin graft
 - With skin flap
 - Other
- 7. Other genitalia procedure**

VIII. SKIN AND ADNEXA

- 1. Skin Tumour Excision**
- 2. Sentinel Lymph-node Biopsy**
- 3. Excision of skin lesion (any type or localization)**
 - Reconstruction with direct closure
 - Reconstruction with skin graft
 - Reconstruction with local skin flap
 - Reconstruction with regional/microvascular flap
 - Shaving /curettage/cauterisation,/cryosurgery
- 4. Skin expansion**
- 5. Vascular Anomalies**
 - Surgical excision for vascular anomaly
 - With complex excision/reconstruction
 - Without complex excision/reconstruction
 - Sclerotherapy for vascular anomaly
 - Other
- 6. Scar revision**
 - Direct closure
 - Z-plasty or similar procedure
 - Dermabrasion, chemical peel
 - Other
- 7. Other skin/adnexal procedure**

IX. BURNS

- 1. Thermal burns**
 - Burn resuscitation
 - Excision and grafting of major burn
 - Excision and grafting of small-medium burns
 - Secondary surgery of burn sequelae
- 2. Surgery for electrical burns**
- 3. Surgery for chemical burns**
- 4. Surgery for extravasation injuries**
- 5. Other burn procedure**

X. PRESSURE SORES

- 1. Reconstruction with direct closure**
- 2. Reconstruction with pedicled flap**

XI. LYMPHEDEMA
